



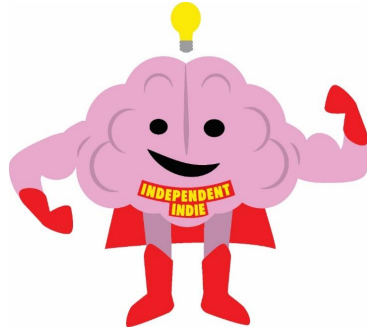
# Outdoor Learning at Lakeside Primary

## Expressive Arts:

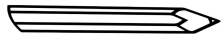
Children will develop their creative skills through outdoor lessons. The photo opposite shows Year 1 pupils creating face images using natural items they had collected outside.

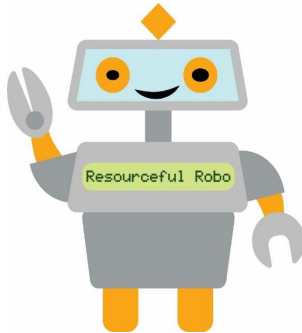

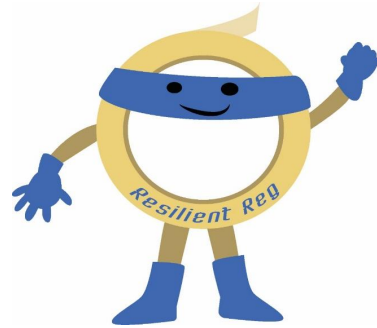




## Science and Technology:
